<p><u>Screamin' Roller Coaster:</u> Glue a piece of yarn onto a paper to make your roller coaster track. Cut out rectangles of color paper to build your roller coaster train. Color in the rest of your picture. Is it night or day in your picture? What is the name of your roller coaster?</p>	<p><u>Nature Art:</u> Collect some sticks, rocks and other items found outside. Arrange your collected nature to make a picture.</p>	<p><u>Trace Art:</u> With assistance, find interesting shaped items in your kitchen drawer that you could trace. Trace your items to make a picture. Don't forget to color your picture.</p>
<p><u>Collage Face:</u> A collage is a piece of art made by sticking various different colors, textures and shapes together. Ask a parent to help you gather supplies of things you could cut up: magazines, colorful paper, cardboard, etc. Using only these items, cut out a head, eyes, ears, mouth, nose and hair. ONLY cutting and gluing, no drawing.</p>	<p><u>Sculpting:</u> If you have clay at your home, see what wonderful sculptures you can make. If you do not have any clay there are several recipes online for salt dough.</p>	<p><u>Lines, Lines and More Lines:</u> There are many kinds of lines: straight, curvy, zigzagged and wavy. Walk around your home with a parent to see which lines are used the most to make items you see.</p>
<p><u>My Favorite Toy:</u> Artists often look at an object they draw. Find your favorite toy. Look and see what kind of lines make your toy. Trace your toy with your finger. Draw and color a picture of your favorite toy. E-mail your picture to your teacher.</p>	<p><u>The Line Game:</u> Play this drawing game with a parent or a sibling. Using only one kind of line, try to draw an object. Players will give other players challenges. Ex: Draw a dog using only straight lines. Draw a person using only wavy lines. Draw a house using only zigzag lines.</p>	<p><u>Another Planet:</u> You are an astronaut and your spaceship has just landed on another planet. Draw a circle on a paper. This is the window of your spaceship. Draw what you see out your window. Are there plants, creatures, buildings? Color your picture.</p>
